Claymont North residents are required to submit to the Architectural Control Committee for approval a simple application with descriptive plans for any exterior modifications to your home or landscaping.

Automobile reminder

Although spring is fast approaching, a few cold winters days still remain. If you're the kind of person who likes to warm up your car before departing for your destination, use extra caution while you wait for your vehicle to become toasty warm: The North Patrol Division of the Police Department has reported two instances in the Northland where suspects stole idling cars while the owners were either absent or distracted:

One homeowner left his car warming up in his driveway with the door unlocked. An individual came along and simply climbed into the car and drove away.

A second instance occurred when a citizen pulled up to use a pay phone and left her car running. While the driver was talking on the phone outside her car, the suspect jumped in and drove away.

Here are some suggestions on how to make sure you are not a victim of these crimes:

- If you are warming up a car in the driveway or on the street, use a second set of keys to lock the car while it idles.
- Never leave your vehicle unattended in public places ... even if only for a moment.
 It's better to turn off your vehicle and restart it after you run your errand.

Make your home more secure with these home-safety tips

- Various sources indicate that simply displaying WINDOW DECALS and/or yard signs can decrease your chances of being burglarized by up to 75 percent.
- You can help secure your WINDOWS from being slid open by placing pins through the window frames.
- A solid door with a double deadbolt lock can delay a burglar; and time to a thief is synonymous to their own safety.
- A piece of wood placed in the window track or pins through the window frames prevent SLIDING GLASS doors from sliding open for the wrong person.

- Let the sun shine in! Open the windows and let the clean, green aroma of spring's new flower and plant life enter your home. Not only will the mustiness of winter be removed, but you'll also protect yourself from inhaling dust and dangerous fumes from cleaning products.
